Going Forward into Employment

Opportunities provide fixed term employment for up to 24 months, of which some positions could be made permanent.

Eligibility

You could be eligible for one of our upcoming opportunities if you have been out of the Armed Forces for less than 5 years and are struggling to secure employment, or have you been medically discharged from the Armed Forces within the past 10 years?

You could also be eligible if you are a Military Spouse/Partner of someone serving or who left the Armed Forces within the last 5 years and due to the commitments, have not been able to establish a career as a result.
